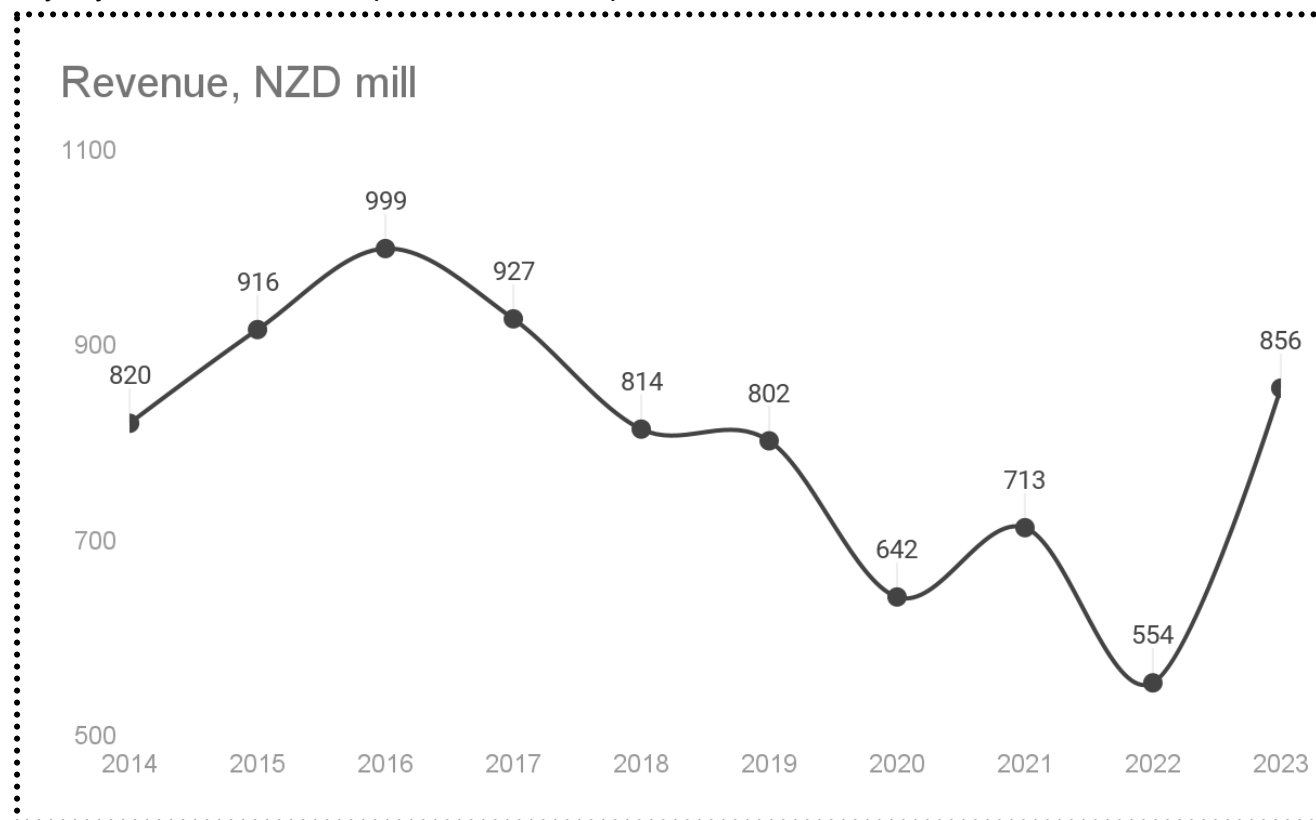

Criticism

In 2020, SkyCity Entertainment Group received financial support in the form of wage subsidies from the New Zealand government as part of a large-scale economic stimulus program following the COVID-19 outbreak. Initially receiving assistance of 21.6 million NZD in taxpayer-funded aid, the company received an additional tranche of \$9.4 million⁴¹ from the central government in July 2020. In total, SkyCity received over \$30 million from New Zealand taxpayers in 2020. Subsequently, after reporting a profit of over 66.2 million NZD⁴², SkyCity steadfastly refused to repay the funds, despite being profitable. This was condemned across the political spectrum in New Zealand⁴³ and referred to as an example of “misuse” and “fraud,” as previously warned by the New Zealand Treasury.⁴⁴

In June 2021, the Australian financial watchdog [AUSTRAC](#) informed SkyCity about “potentially serious breaches” of anti-money laundering rules at their Adelaide casino. Investigation into SkyCity Adelaide had been initiated in September 2019 and focused on the management of customers identified as high-risk groups and politically exposed persons during the time periods between July 1, 2015, and June 30, 2016, as well as July 1, 2018, and June 30, 2019. In an official statement, SkyCity announced that they had received notification from AUSTRAC that it would request additional information from SkyCity as part of its investigation. “SkyCity will fully cooperate with AUSTRAC regarding these investigations and the investigation into SkyCity Adelaide,” SkyCity said.⁴⁵

In December 2022, SkyCity faced a lawsuit from AUSTRAC regarding alleged failures at SkyCity Adelaide, which led to an accusation of “systemic failures” in combating illegal activities. Analysts anticipate potential fines of 50 million NZD (\$54.5 million) as a result of investigations by state and federal governments, but this could be a conservative estimate and SkyCity may end up paying more. Jarden analysts Adrian Olbon and Jason Cao stated that, in their expectations, the company might pay this amount by 2024. The company stated: “SkyCity Adelaide will continue to cooperate with AUSTRAC on a broader scale, especially in the context of ongoing improvements to its AML/CTF control system in Adelaide, as indicated in SkyCity's FY22 annual report.”⁴⁶

Analyst's opinion

SkyCity Entertainment Group is a publicly-traded company engaged in gambling and entertainment in Australia and New Zealand. SkyCity owns and operates 5 casinos, 19 restaurants, 12 bars, 3 hotels, and other properties (office/commercial spaces, parking, Sky Tower), as well as an online casino in Malta. As of June 30, 2023, the company has 4,559 employees.

SkyCity's shares are traded on the Australian Stock Exchange and New Zealand's Exchange. More than 50% of the company is owned by institutional investors.

A snapshot of the company's dividend information for the past 4 years indicates variability in dividend payouts. In 2021, there was a negative growth trend of 30% compared to 2020, with dividends at 7.0 NZD (cents) per share. In 2022, no dividends were paid. In 2023, dividends amounted to 12.0 NZD (cents) per share. Additional analysis of the period from 2015 to 2019 revealed that the average dividend payout was 20.0 NZD (cents) per share.⁴⁷ By comparing these figures, it can be concluded that there has been a significant reduction in dividend payments.

A retrospective revenue look indicates a decline in the company's income from 2017 to 2022. In 2022, the decline was 44.54% compared to 2016 results. In 2023, the total revenue amounted to 856 million NZD. This is an increase of 54.51% compared to 2022 but still 14.31% lower than 2016 figures.

The period from 2020 to 2022 was challenging for the company as it faced financial difficulties due to the COVID-19 situation. SkyCity operates in the consumer services sector, with its primary sources of revenue being casinos and hospitality services. This explains the decline in the company's income and the unstable dividend payouts in recent years. The legal lawsuit from AUSTRAC and associated fines have also negatively impacted the company's income and reputation.

In 2016, SkyCity developed a 'sustainable development strategy,' which was subsequently supplemented and expanded. The work aimed at achieving the strategy's goals requires investments in strategic directions, which may be a reason for the company's short-term revenue decline.

The 2023 FY shows positive dynamics compared to the previous 5 years, driven by the company's recovery after the lifting of COVID-19 restrictions. The development of the online casino strategy implies some diversification of the company's activities, but accounts for only 1.75% of the total sales volume in 2023.

In 2024 and 2025, SkyCity expects the completion of the Horizon Hotel and New Zealand International Convention Centre projects, respectively.⁴⁸
